



## **NOTICE OF THE 2015 SKATE AUSTRALIA INLINE SPEED SKATING MARATHON (INVITATIONAL)**

DATES: 18<sup>th</sup> January 2015

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### **1. NOMINATIONS**

- (a) Nominations must be forwarded and all registration/nomination fees paid by **4:00pm on Friday 9<sup>th</sup> January 2015**. Nominations are to be forwarded to:

Registration and nomination fees must be paid by direct deposit, to

Please email Rhoda Bueker on [treasurer@savspeed.com](mailto:treasurer@savspeed.com) when a direct deposit is made with details including payment date, amount paid and payment description.

- (b) Qualifications for entry into the various grades are set out in the rules of the various branches. Where age determines eligibility for entry in a particular grade, it shall be decided by the age of the skater on 31<sup>st</sup> December 2015. Refer to SA Inc. By-law No. 11 Sanctions and Competitions for information concerning the number of skaters eligible for nomination.
- (c) Skaters must be a member of their respective countries' federation.

### **2. FEES**

- (a) Registration and Nomination Fees: (Combined Fee)  
Speed Registration & Nomination Fee for the Marathon is \$85.00 Inc. GST.

### **3. NUMBER PATCHES**

States are to provide their own speed number patches. Three number patches shall be worn by each competitor – one on the lower back and one on each hip.

### **4. SUITABLE DRESS FOR EVENTS AND WARM UPS**

- (a) Specific rules apply for speed events and the referees shall see that these rules are upheld.

### **5. PRESENTATIONS**

- (a) All presentations shall be made, where possible, as indicated in the program.
- (b) Skaters should assemble in the marshalling area and be ready for the presentation.
- (c) Skaters receiving medals must be in full competition outfits.

### **6. RULES**

- (a) Copies of all appropriate rules and regulations shall be supplied by the CSOC Chairman and kept in the Championship Director's Office.
- (b) Under no circumstance may those copies of rules be removed from that office.



## **7. PROTESTS**

- (a) All skaters should refer to the appropriate rules as set out by the ASC.
- (b) Protest fees are set at \$100.00 per event and must accompany all protests. This fee shall be held by the Chairman of the CSOC. Fees shall be refunded if protests are upheld. If the protest is not upheld the money will be given to the Branch Chairperson for deposit into General Funds.

## **8. MEDICAL COSTS**

- (a) For injuries received during the competition proper or the official warm up prior to the event, medical and hospital costs should be claimed from Medicare and then through Skate Australia's National Insurance Scheme. However please note that Skate Australia's National Insurance Scheme only covers non-Medicare expenses.
- (b) International skaters must have their own Insurance.

## **9. CHAMPIONSHIP DIRECTOR**

- (a) The Championship Director is Mrs. Pauline Robertson, Chairperson of the Australia Speed Committee (ASC).
- (b) Technical matters come under the jurisdiction of the appropriate commissioned official or the branch committee chairman or his/her nominee.
