

# Skate Australia Victoria Speed Race Series – 2015 Sanction



## Summary of Events:

- 10 Events (5 Track, 5 Road) commencing on 22/2/15 and ending on 28/11/15
- Full up-to-date racing schedule is on the website at <http://www.savspeed.com>
- Cost is \$20 per single event or a discount price of \$100 (prepaid) for all 10 events
- Family discount on prepaid of \$10 per family member- 1<sup>st</sup> \$100, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$90, 3<sup>rd</sup> \$80 etc
- No refunds will be given for prepaid memberships once EV1 has been completed. Prepaid memberships are not available after EV2 has completed.

## Regulations and General Information:

1. The SAVS Race Series is open to all currently registered SA Competitive and Development members. If you have not already raced in Victoria, you will need to participate in an assessment exercise on Track which will determine whether you can commence racing and, if so, which division you will be placed in.
2. The competition divisions are mixed gender and ability based and include: Senior A, Senior B, Senior C, Junior A, Junior B, Junior C and Junior D. The SAVS Committee will determine which division skaters will compete in and may add, remove or change divisions as required. In 2015 one race block per Event will be restricted to single gender – same divisions will apply but will be combined if there are less than 5 competitors – no points are awarded for these races.
3. **NOMINATIONS:** All nominations are to be made through clubs by the FRIDAY the week prior to the event (i.e. 8 days in advance), along with the payment of any fees. Late nominations will be accepted upon payment of late nomination fee of \$20 which is additional to any other costs. Nominations are to be sent to [noms@savspeed.com](mailto:noms@savspeed.com) and these noms must also detail payments made by each club.
4. All indoor races shall be conducted according to the Australian Speed Rule Book. All outdoor races shall be conducted according to the International Rule Book.
5. For each Race Series event, all Clubs must appoint a Team Manager who is the only Club representative authorised to approach the Officials (via the Chief Referee) on any competition racing related matter.

6. The maximum allowable wheel diameter is 110mm and the maximum skate length is 50cm. However frame and wheel restrictions apply to all Skate Australia Victoria registered competitors, under the age of 14 years as at the 31st December.

Skaters are required to abide by the restrictions listed in the table to be eligible to compete.

7. Skaters in all divisions will be awarded points in all races at all Race Series events, excluding relays and the special single gender races as noted above in point 2. Points are awarded on a per race basis as follows - 1st 10pts, 2nd 8pts, 3rd 6pts, 4th 5pts, 5th 4pts, 6th 3pts, 7th 2pts and 1pt for each other finisher. Junior A, B, C and D categories will receive ribbons for overall placings at each Race Series event. Overall prize(s) for the season will be presented at or after the end of the series.
8. Skaters may move between divisions upon application to the SAVS Committee. Any points earned in any division stay in that division and are not carried to the new division.
9. Helmets must be worn at all times while on skates. Gloves must be worn at all times while on skates on the road surface. No exceptions will be made to this rule.
10. Any skater, official, coach or spectator who behaves in an inappropriate manner may be disqualified from the competition and/or removed from the venue. Further action may also be taken in accordance with the SAV Speed by-law covering Disciplinary Procedures.
11. By nominating for any of the above mentioned events, skaters agree to abide by the regulations and conditions outlined in this sanction. Skaters should refer to the Australian Speed Rule Book for lodging protests. A fee of \$100 must accompany any protests.

12. **Victorian Championships Eligibility:** To be eligible to compete at the Victorian Championships in October 2015, each skater must have competed in two Race Series Track events (to qualify for Track) and two Race Series Road Events (to qualify for Road) since the previous Victorian Championships in the previous year.
