

SKATE AUSTRALIA VICTORIA SPEED 2015 SPRINT SERIES SANCTION



Summary of Events:

- 3 events to be held on 22/08/2015, 27/09/2015 & 17/10/2015
- Events to be held at Casey Fields and at Knox Regional Netball Courts
- Cost is \$5 per single event or a discount price of \$10 (prepaid) for all 3 events
- No refunds will be given

Regulations and General Information:

1. The SAVS Sprint Series is open to all currently registered SA Competitive members.
2. The competition divisions are mixed gender and ability based and include: Senior A, Senior B, Senior C, Junior A, Junior B, Junior C and Junior D. The SAVS Committee will determine which division skaters will compete in and may add, remove or change divisions as required.
3. **Nominations:** All nominations are to be made through clubs by the Wednesday of the event (i.e - 3 days in advance), along with the payment of any fees. Late nominations **will** be accepted up to the beginning of the event upon payment of the nomination fee. Nominations are to be sent to noms@savspeed.com and these noms must also detail payments made by each club.
4. All outdoor races shall be conducted according to the **FIRS CIC Regulations 01/05/2015**.
5. Starting conditions will be as per the sprint events outlined in the FIRS CIC Regulations 01/05/2015. Skaters must skate within their lane, any skater who touches a white line will be judged as out of their lane and will be disqualified. Times will be recorded for all competitors in each round.
6. **Best individual times in this series will be used to rank skaters for the 2015 Vic Championships.**
7. For each Sprint Series event, **all clubs must appoint a Team Manager** who is the only Club representative authorised to approach the Officials (via the Chief Referee) on any competition racing related matter.
8. The maximum allowable wheel diameter is 110mm and the maximum skate length is 50cm. However, frame and wheel restrictions apply to all Skate Australia Victoria registered competitors under the age of 14 years as at the 31st December. Skaters are required to abide by the restrictions listed in the table to be eligible to compete.

9. Prizes will be awarded in all divisions at each event. Prizes in each division will be for the Quickest Average Time achieved by Female and Quickest Average Time achieved by Male, recorded over multiple rounds. An Overall Prize will also be awarded across the series for the Best Time recorded.
10. Helmets must be worn at all times while on skates. Gloves must be worn at all times while on skates on the road surface. No exceptions to this rule.
11. Any skater, official, coach or spectator who behaves in an inappropriate manner may be disqualified from the competition and/or removed from the venue. Further action may also be taken in accordance with the SAV Speed by-law covering Disciplinary Procedures.
12. By nominating for any of the above mentioned events, skaters agree to abide by the regulations and conditions outlined in this sanction.
